Dear Parents,

Your child's faith formation started on the day you had your child baptized. It was at that point you acknowledged and committed to teach and nurture your child in the Catholic faith. As a church community we are committed to support and help you with this undertaking. We are asking you to seriously consider the attached documents.

Please read carefully the documents entitled "Come to Class and Come to Mass". We are partners with you in your child's faith formation. We will faithfully offer Religious Education classes and we need you to do your part – Bring your child to class and Mass.

Plans are already underway for next year's Religious Education program. Most of you have already determined the grade school that your child will attend in the fall. It is also the time to plan on your child's faith formation classes. We are asking that you register for Sunday School now. This will give us an indication of the class size and the number of books that we will need to order. It will help us reduce class sizes by planning on an appropriate number of teachers.

You will be expected to fill out a registration form each year. This is one way for us to verify your information. The registration form for this coming year has changed. Please note that we are asking for parent information as well as each individual child's sacramental information. If you are interested in volunteering to teach or work as an aide in Sunday School, please indicate that also.

The fee for Sunday School is \$35.00 per child or \$60.00 per family. This will not cover the entire cost of supplies but is appropriate as a commitment towards the support of our program. The registration forms are due back by July 1, 2006. There will be a late fee of \$5.00 per form after that date. The forms can be turned in to the Church office, School office, or the collection basket. Please place the form and fee in an envelope marked "Sunday School". Include your family Affirmation form – Come to Class and Come to Mass.
